The PlayStation Store for PS3 is an online virtual market that contains both free of charge and for sale downlose trailers and other games related goodies while the latter is emulated PlayStation or Arcade games and PlaySt demos or public beta, have a monthly limited availability. Once removed from the store they still can be downlow monitoring, one's bought content can be downloaded on up to five different PlayStation 3 using a guest user at multiple PlayStation 3s are the PSN games *Warhawk* and Gran Turismo 5 Prologue. 




Video Store

The Video Store (originally Video Marketplace) is an online service operated by Microsoft that is used to distribute television shows and movies to Xbox 360 owners. The service was launched in USA on November 22, 2006 via Xbox Live. Initial content partners include Paramount Pictures, CBS, TBS, MTV Networks, UFC, NBC, and Warner Bros. Home Entertainment. Other movie studios have since supported the service including Lionsgate Films and Walt Disney Pictures as announced at E3 2007.^[6] At CES 2008, MGM, ABC, the Disney Channel and Toon Disney announced their support for the service.^[6] At the present time, the service is available to users in the United States, Canada, UK, Ireland, France and Germany.

Various films and TV shows are available for purchase in the Video Store, including both past and present series, such as *Star Trek* and *CSI: Crime Scene Investigation*.^[7] TV shows will be saved permanently while movies are only "rentals"; they will become unwatchable 24 hours after initial viewing or 14 days after purchase.

TiVo's partnership with YouTube will deliver Web video directly to user's televisions. The catch is to get YouTube content you must own the latest TiVo HD and TiVo Series3 models.

"TiVo's strategy is to bridge the gap between Web video and television and make as much content available as possible for our subscribers," said Tara Maitra, vice president and general manager for content services at TiVo (New York Times).




